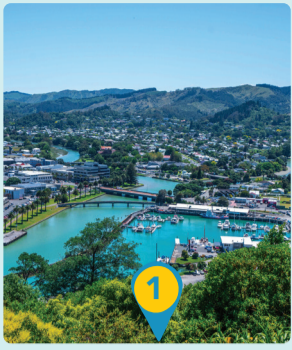


Gis' borne to shine...

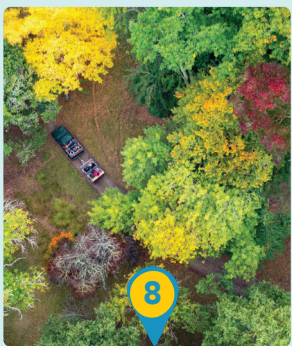


ASTRO TOURS

UAWA - TOLAGA BAY

RUATORIA

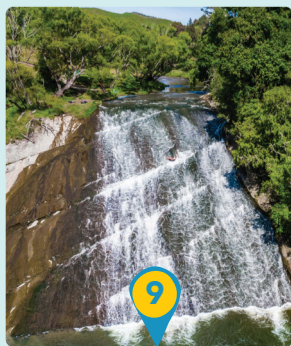

AIR RUATORIA

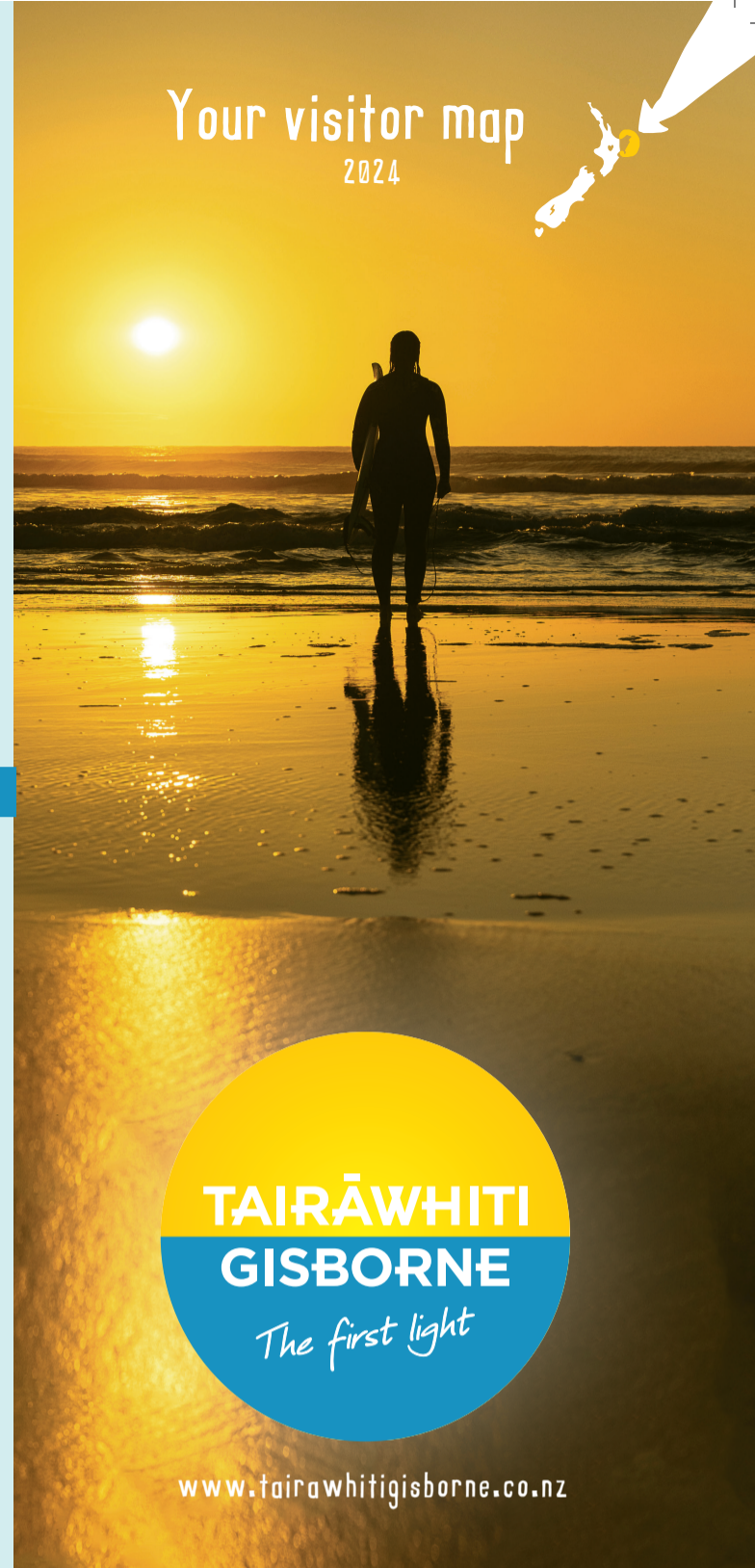

MAUNGA HIKURANGI

Maunga Hikurangi is the sacred mountain of the Ngati Porou people, and the first place in the world to see the sunrise. Visitors are transported up on 4WD UTV's by local guides. Once at the top, visitors will arrive at a sacred site with nine Māori carvings that depict the stories of Maui.

TIKITIKI

Immerse yourself in the beauty of St Mary's Church with its Māori architectural design, wonderful carvings and tukutuku (woven panels) inside. It's considered one of the finest Māori churches in New Zealand.



TE ARAROA

Here you'll find the largest Pōhutukawa tree in the world 'Te Waha o Rerekohu'. Immerse yourself into Māori culture and history hosted by Ngā Taonga o Hinerupe or head to the most easterly point in mainland NZ to the East Cape Lighthouse. Be the first in the world to see the sun rise.



MOTU TRAILS

Get on a bike and enjoy one of the Great Rides that make up Ngā Haerenga, The New Zealand Cycle Trails. The Motu Trails offer everything from easy family riding to true back country escape.
